Flexi-boarding

The College offer the option to flexi-board where families can pre-select the specific night(s) each week to board across an entire term. Booked termly in advance, your child is guaranteed the same bed in the same House on the relevant night. If the four night Flexi-boarding option is taken, the College will also guarantee the bed-space will be for the sole use of your child. Flexi-boarding must be for a fixed number of nights but does not have to be for consecutive nights (e.g., a pupil committing to the 'Two Night' option might stay Mondays and Thursdays each week. The charge per term (in addition to the day fee plus day pupil meal charge) is:

Occasional Boarding

In addition to the Flexi-boarding, the College will continue to offer Occasional Boarding for those parents wishing to book a space on an *ad hoc* basis. With Occasional Boarding you should note that the same bed in the same House is not guaranteed. The Occasional Boarding fee will be £55 per night in the Senior School and £45 per night in the Prep School up to a maximum number of six nights during the academic year 2017/18. Thereafter, a charge of £75 per night will apply in the Senior School and £65 per night in the Prep School.

Day Pupils' Meals

(Meals are itemised separately)

Senior School - Lunch (Mon - Sat) £335 per term. This is not optional and will be added to the termly account in arrears.

Suppers £4.15 each (optional)

Preparatory School - Lunch (Mon - Fri) £250 per term. This is not optional and will be added to the termly account in arrears.

Saturday lunches £3.70 each (optional). Breakfast £2.25 each (optional). Suppers £3.10 each (optional).

A refund for missed meals will only be made where a day pupil is absent due to illness for a period of five consecutive days or more.

Fees are adjusted by the amount received in EU milk subsidy towards the cost of milk provided for day and boarding pupils.

Transport to School by Wycliffe Minibus

The College partly subsidises transport by minibus for day pupils. A fixed charge will be made and recovered termly on account.

Personal Accident Insurance

Personal Accident Insurance is provided at no additional cost.

The Wycliffian Society (TWS)

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

WHOLE SCHOOL

Academic Coaching

Individual learning support lessons for children with Special Educational Needs is £42.50 for 50 mins (£30 for 35 mins). Any other extra tuition by the School staff outside the normal timetable is charged at the same rate. Teaching of English as an Additional Language is a maximum of £42.50 for 50 mins for individual tuition. Group rates are available on request.

College Squash Team

Team members are charged £430 per term, which covers the provision of the full coaching programme, entry fees and transport to all tournaments in the competition calendar, including one European event and Wycliffe competition clothing.

Fencing Club

Membership of Wycliffe Fencing Club: £67 per term. Other costs may include competition entry fees and personal equipment.

Music Lessons

Parents' Association

The termly subscription is £25 per family for Senior School pupils, £10 for Preparatory School and £28 per family where pupils are in both Senior School and Preparatory School.

SENIOR SCHOOL ONLY

Combined Cadet Force

There is a termly subscription of £33 per cadet to cover adventure training, transport and miscellaneous costs. Uniforms (excluding boots & t-shirts), rations and all other equipment are provided free of charge but losses must be paid for.

Rowing Club

(a) Membership of British Rowing: £17 - £34 per annum, (b) Membership of Wycliffe Rowing Club £133 per term.

PREPARATORY SCHOOL ONLY

Cub Scouts and Scouts

Cub Scouts and Scouts both charged at £27 per term but subject to review on notification from the District Scout Association. Uniforms extra.

Lower Prep Breakfast Club

Available for children in Reception, Years 1 and 2. The charge for Lower Prep Breakfast Club from 8:00am to 8:25am is £1.65 per day including breakfast.

ACCOUNTS

Discount

A 1% discount off the net termly fee (excluding lunches and extras) will apply for the academic year 2017/18 where full payment is made by Direct Debit only on the first day of term.

Unpaid Fees

Interest will be charged on overdue fees calculated on a daily basis at the rate of 1% per calendar month. A charge of £10 per item will be made for returned cheques and Direct Debits.

Pocket Money

Pupils requesting pocket money may only do so where they have written authority from their parents, the account is fully paid up and the College holds an additional deposit for pocket money in excess of the amount required.
