



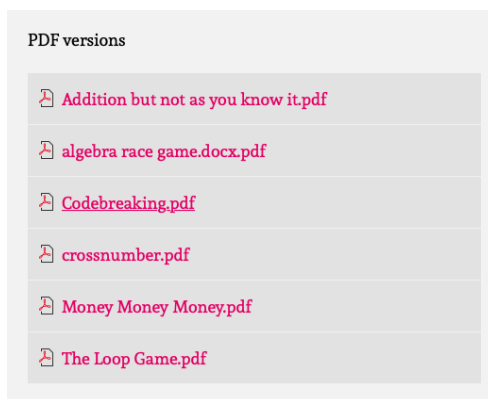
# Wycliffe PDFs on a Mac

## Adobe Acrobat

If you don't have Adobe Acrobat Reader, you can download it for free. It enables you to view PDFs. <https://get.adobe.com/uk/reader/>

If it is a worksheet for you to write on, you could then print it, work on it and then just take a photo/scan of your work.

Try to find the PDF version of the activity. (It will say .PDF at the end of the file name.)

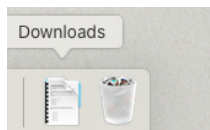


## Download

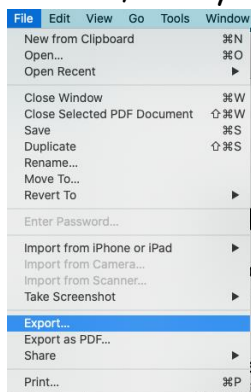
Click the icon on the right hand side to download the file.



Go to the Downloads folder.



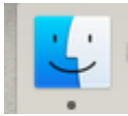
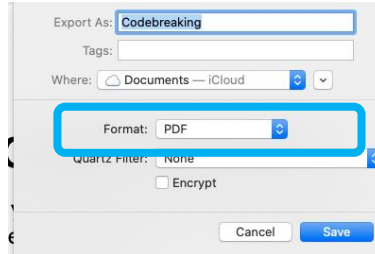
You could then just print the worksheet, or if you go to then export...
