Students applying for the 13+ Art Scholarship will submit **one A1 board of artwork** in response to a set theme. The A1 board can have a range of work presented on it. We would like to see the candidates demonstrating a range of skills from drawing, photography, textiles, painting, printmaking and ceramics. There is no requirement for a portfolio or framed work. Candidates should photograph any work that is 3-Dimensional and present it on the A1 board.
