Information for Candidates

Candidates at 16+ will be playing sport to an outstanding level within their age group (be that at international, county, regional or academy level). It is recognised that 16+ Scholars will be looking to balance their academic studies alongside their commitment and focus on developing themselves in their chosen sport. We therefore provide mentoring and coaching to ensure pupils are able to work towards achieving their sporting and academic requirements.

Application

As part of the standard Sixth Form entrance procedure, all external candidates will be required to sit CAT 4 entrance tests. Candidates who demonstrate the greatest academic potential in these tests and who have expressed formally an interest in competing for a scholarship by returning a completed entry form will then be invited to attend the Scholarship Assessment Day.

It is anticipated that an award-holder will show commitment to the wider academic, sporting, artistic and cultural life of our school community. The ability to make a meaningful impact on Sixth Form life will also be considered in making the award of a scholarship.
