Wycliffe College has an enviable sporting heritage. All sports scholars are expected to be fully committed to sport at the College and will be excellent role models for all Wycliffe College pupils to aspire to and will also demonstrate the highest level of sportsmanship. It is expected that sport scholars will show a sustained commitment to sport throughout their time at the College.

13+ Sports Scholarships

Awards will be made to candidates who demonstrate outstanding performance or potential in at least one of our team sports:

Rugby, football, hockey, cricket, netball, basketball

Information for Candidates:

- Scholarship candidates at 13+ are expected to be all-round athletes who will be able to offer at least two of Wycliffe's main sports
- At 13+ we look to assess all-round athletic ability as well as sport specific ability
- All candidates will be expected to be able to do the following
 - Perform in three sporting assessments on the day
 OR
 - Perform in at least two sporting assessments on the day and have another sport that they wish to be considered.
 - This is usually a sport that we do not offer in school but the candidate is competing at a good level. Previous examples include, swimming, equestrian, sailing, polo etc.
- Please arrive in sports kit and bring a full water bottle with you
- The sporting assessments will be very much focused on skills and ability

- There will be snacks and drinks available in the sports hall at break time and throughout the morning, lunch will be provided where required
- When not involved in an assessment, pupils will be able to use the sports hall pavilion to wait and store their kit
- Pupils will be directed to each activity by a member of staff
- Please bring the appropriate kit for your sports:
 - Gum shield
 - Shin pads
 - Trainers/boots/astros (football will be assessed on the astro turf, rugby will be assessed on the grass)
 - Hockey stick
 - Cricket pads and equipment (pupils wishing to be assessed in cricket should have their own equipment)
 - Appropriate clothing for the physical assessments and your sport

Format of the Assessment

- Core movement skills and physical assessment
- An interview with the Director of Sport
- Evidence of team play and sportsmanship in a non-core sport

A full timetable for the Assessment Day will be sent to pupils in advance of the Assessment Day.
