This fee information sheet is designed to be an accessible and useful summary of current fees for Rendcomb families and sits as a supplement to the published fee schedule on our main website page. Please read our website page for further information on pledges Wycliffe is making to transferring families.

Our All-Inclusive Fee

Wycliffe's fees are all-inclusive in all age groups which means that we aim to charge very few extras on top of the termly fee. Our all-inclusive fees includes the following, without additional charge:

- Full 'wrap around' care from Nursery to Year 13 for day pupils
 - Breakfast Club from 8.00am in Nursery and Prep
 - In Nursery: After-School Care until 6.00pm (includes Supper)
 - In Prep: Supervised Prep or Activity Sessions run from the end of the School day until 5.30pm, with the option to extend until 6.00pm (option to extend to 6.00pm includes Supper)
 - In Senior: Day pupils may remain at school until 9.00pm (includes prep time and Dinner)
- Lunch and snacks
- All tuition and textbooks
- Most school co-curricular activities (some specialist activities such as Flying Club, CCF, DofE attract a supplementary charge)
- All School trips which are curriculum-based
- Games and travel to/from matches (including home match teas)
- Learning Support: provision for our SWANS (Students With Additional Needs) is in the curriculum, rather than an "extra".
 - Prep School: Small group sessions are conducted without any additional charge; there is an additional rate for 1:1 sessions in consultation with our Prep Head of Learning Support
 - Senior School: Learning Support sessions in Years 9-13 are offered in small, group sessions of targeted support and intervention, which is included in our fee structure and timetabled into the school day. 1:1 provision for those pupils who require it in line with our graduated response is also included. Where capacity allows, we can also offer additional 1:1 support beyond that, included in our provision at an hourly rate

Our Boarding fees include all of the above plus:

- Breakfast
- Supper and evening snacks
- Housekeeping and Laundry services
- In-house activities during the week and at weekends
- Stays at Exeat Weekends (all boarders may stay free of charge at school on Exeat Weekends should they need to)

Boarding (From Year 3 upwards)

Wycliffe offers full, flexi and occasional boarding is available to suit families' needs. We accept boarders from Year 3 upwards. Boarders enjoy a full programme of evening/weekend activities and access to facilities on the College site.

Each house is run by a Housemaster or Housemistress, with resident assistant staff and full-time day matrons (including on Saturdays) to support them. Each house has a team of teaching staff attached to them as the non-resident team. Pupils' health, wellbeing and safety is of paramount importance and our Health Centre, which is staffed by fully qualified and experienced nurses, are on call 24 hours a day. They also enable access to the School GP, counsellors and a physiotherapist, as well as other specialist services.

Occasional Boarding* (From Year 3 upwards)

Wycliffe offers Occasional Boarding for parents who wish to book boarding on an ad hoc basis. Please note that with Occasional Boarding, the same bed in the same house cannot be guaranteed. The fee for Occasional Boarding is £74 per night (Prep) and £85 per night (in Senior), up to a maximum of six nights in any Academic Year. Beyond this limit, the charge will increase to £115 per night (in Prep) or £125 per night (in Senior).

Flexi-Boarding* (From Year 3 upwards)

Wycliffe offers a Flexi-boarding package, allowing families to pre-select specific nights for their child to board each week across the term. Booked in advance on a termly basis, your child is guaranteed the same bed (in the same house, in the Senior School) on their chosen nights. For those opting for the four-night Flexi-boarding package, Wycliffe ensures that the bed space is exclusively reserved for your child. Flexi-boarding requires a fixed number of nights each week but does not need to be consecutive (e.g. a pupil choosing the 'Two-Night' option might board on Mondays and Thursdays). The additional charge per term for this option, on top of the Day Fee, is:

Registration and Deposits

Please note that for all pupils transferring from Rendcomb, the non-refundable registration fee will be waived and deposits on entry to the Wycliffe will be matched to those requested by Rendcomb. Wycliffe will also delay the taking of a deposit until families have received their deposits back from Rendcomb.

On entry into the Prep School from the UK	£250
On entry into the Senior School from the UK	£500
For international entrants into Senior School who reside within the EU	£1,500
For international entrants into the Prep School who reside outside the EU	£8,500
For international entrants into the Senior School who reside outside the EU	£15,000

For the purpose of deposits and related charges, an international pupil is defined as a pupil who does not hold British nationality or who requires immigration sponsorship (e.g. a Child Student visa) to study in the United Kingdom.

International pupils transferring from Wycliffe Prep to Year 9 will be required to increase their deposit to the level applicable for Senior School international entrants

Sibling Discount Policy

A Sibling Discount of 5% is offered on fees (excluding extras) for the second and subsequent siblings* from the same family, provided two or more siblings are enrolled at Wycliffe at the same time. The discount will be applied to each sibling (excluding the eldest) while they are concurrently in attendance.

***Wycliffe pledges to match Rendcomb's sibling discount of 15% for any families joining with three or more children (with the 15% discount applied to the third child and any additional siblings).**

Please note:

- Where a pupil is in receipt of a bursary, scholarship, or other fee remission, the sibling discount may not apply. The application of sibling discounts in such cases remains at the discretion of the College.
- Sibling discount does not apply to pupils whose fees are supported by the Continuity of Education Allowance (CEA). This policy reflects existing fee arrangements and conditions associated with CEA funding.

Sibling discount will be applied to the fee in the term where the eligibility is identified, either by parents or the Fees Manager. It will not be applied retrospectively

Continuing Education Allowance for Military Families

Families eligible for the Continuing Education Allowance (CEA) are required to pay 10% of the Boarding fee (excluding extras and other charges).

Other Charges

Academic Coaching

Individual learning support lessons for children with Special Educational Needs are charged at £55 for 45 minutes or £43 for 35 minutes. Any additional tuition provided by School staff outside the normal timetable is charged at the same rate.

For pupils requiring English as an Additional Language (EAL), individual tuition is also available at £55 for 45 minutes. Group tuition rates are available upon request.

College Squash Team

Team members are charged £545 per term, which includes the full coaching programme, entry fees, and transport to all tournaments in the competition calendar. This also covers participation in one European event and the provision of Wycliffe competition clothing.

Combined Cadet Force

There is a termly subscription of £39 per cadet to cover adventure training, transport and miscellaneous costs. Uniforms (excluding boots and t-shirts), rations and all other equipment are provided free of charge, but losses must be paid for.

Music Lessons

Instrumental lessons: £305 per term (10 lessons).
Hire of School instruments: £45 per term.

Parents Association

The termly subscription is £25 per family for Senior School pupils, and £29 per family when pupils are in both the Senior School and Prep School.

Plays, Concerts, Expeditions and Trips

The School may subsidise the cost of expeditions related to the curriculum. However, full charges will apply for optional visits.

Pupil's Personal Possessions

The Council of Trustees does not accept responsibility for claims arising from the loss of, or damage to, pupils' property. Parents are advised to arrange coverage through an appropriate extension of their Household Insurance policy.

Transport by Wycliffe Minibus

Wycliffe operates a fleet of modern minibuses, providing transport for children to and from School across Gloucestershire, Wiltshire, Bristol, and South Wales. Our minibus routes are flexible and regularly reviewed to ensure we can accommodate all families who wish to use our safe, convenient, and reliable transport service. The Wycliffian Society (TWS)

All former pupils of Wycliffe automatically become members of TWS, which exists to support all Wycliffians throughout their lives. TWS arranges social and networking events to provide opportunities to keep in touch and for wider social and business connections. This is financed by a charge of £50 per term for nine terms starting in Reception or on arrival at the Prep School or Senior School except for new Sixth Form entrants where a charge of £75 for six terms will apply. If a pupil leaves Wycliffe before paying all termly instalments, a charge will be made on the final account in respect of the outstanding termly amounts due and payable, such that a total of £450 has been paid for membership.
