## Siblings Discount Policy

A Sibling Discount of 5% is offered on fees (excluding extras) for the second and subsequent siblings from the same family, provided two or more siblings are enrolled at the College at the same time. The discount will be applied to each sibling (excluding the eldest) while they are concurrently in attendance. Please note:

- Where a pupil is in receipt of a bursary, scholarship, or other fee remission, the sibling discount may not apply. The application of sibling discounts in such cases remains at the discretion of the College.
- Sibling discount does not apply to pupils whose fees are supported by the Continuity of Education Allowance (CEA). This policy reflects existing fee arrangements and conditions associated with CEA funding.

Sibling discount will be applied to the fee in the term where the eligibility is identified, either by parents or the Fees Manager. It will not be applied retrospectively.

## Other Charges for the academic year commencing September 2026 (inclusive of VAT, where applicable)

### Academic Coaching

Individual learning support lessons for children with Special Educational Needs are charged at £58 for 45 minutes or £45 for 35 minutes. Any additional tuition provided by College staff outside the normal timetable is charged at the same rate.

For pupils requiring English as an Additional Language (EAL), individual tuition is also available at £58 for 45 minutes. Group tuition rates are available upon request.

### Combined Cadet Force

There is a termly subscription of £72 per cadet to cover adventure training, summer camp, transport and miscellaneous costs. Uniforms (excluding boots and t-shirts), rations and all other equipment are provided free of charge, but losses must be paid for.

### Clubs and Activities

The College offer various clubs and activities i.e. Fencing, Golf, LAMDA, Polo, Shooting, Squash. Charged at cost plus transport.

### Music Lessons

Instrumental lessons: £305 per term (10 lessons).

Hire of College instruments: £45 per term.

### Parents Association

The termly subscription is:

- £12 per family for Prep School pupils;
- £25 per family for Senior School pupils; and
- £29 per family when pupils are in both the Senior School and Prep School

### Plays, Concerts, Expeditions and Trips

The College may subsidise the cost of expeditions related to the curriculum. However, full charges will apply for optional visits.

### Pupil's Personal Possessions

The College does not accept responsibility for claims arising from the loss of, or damage to, pupils' property. Parents are advised to arrange coverage through an appropriate extension of their Household Insurance policy.

### Transport by Wycliffe Minibus

Wycliffe operates a fleet of modern minibuses, providing transport for children to and from College across Gloucestershire, Wiltshire, Bristol, and South Wales. Our minibus routes are flexible and regularly reviewed to ensure we can accommodate all families who wish to use our safe, convenient, and reliable transport service. ### The Wycliffian Society (TWS)

All former pupils of Wycliffe automatically become members of TWS, which exists to support all Wycliffians throughout their lives. TWS arranges social and networking events to provide opportunities to keep in touch and for wider social and business connections. This is financed by a charge of £50 per term for nine terms starting in Reception or on arrival at the Prep School or Senior School except for new Sixth Form entrants where a charge of £75 for six terms will apply. If a pupil leaves Wycliffe before paying all termly instalments, a charge will be made on the final account in respect of the outstanding termly amounts due and payable, such that a total of £450 has been paid for membership.

## ACCOUNTS

School fees (and where applicable Flexi-boarding) are invoiced in advance and are payable on the first day of term. All other supplemental/extra charges are invoices in arrears are payable on the first day of term.

### Personal Accident Insurance

### Discount

A 1% discount on the termly fee (excluding extras) will be applied when full payment is made via Direct Debit on the first day of the term.

### Fees in Advance

### Notice of Withdrawal of a Pupil or Change of Status

In accordance with the College's terms and conditions, if you wish to withdraw your child from the College (other than at the normal leaving date which is at the end of year 13), you must either give us a term's notice to that effect or pay to the College a term's fees in lieu of notice, at the rate that would have been charged for the final term of provision if a term's notice had been given.
